Step One: A Consultation

A consultation is needed to receive more information at the situation being presented.

Step Two: Pay a deposit fee

A retainer fee is the amount that is paid upfront before performing any legal work, and is non refundable. Price will vary

Step Three The lawyer will file petitions

Usually we file the petitions within 72 hours. The other party has 30 days to respond. After the 30 days we will get you into court as soon as possible.

Step Four: There may be possible motion hearings

You will be advised 2 weeks prior to the court date if you must appear in court in person or via zoom. We will let you know reason for the hearing or if we need any type of evidence to present your case.

Step Five: Disposition/Trial

The case will conclude if there is an agreement with the other party. Or there will be a trial if no agreement can be made. You would need to appear in court.
